ACTION REQUIRED: Staff seeking to obtain their CDA coursework through continued.com will complete the identified CDA courses listed below (e.g., CDA Part 1) through the CDA Part 1 coursework package.

IMPORTANT: To avoid CDA Part 1 registration issues, **only** complete CDA Part 1 identified courses through the CDA package. Failure to do so will impede the ability to complete the CDA Credential Part 1 course (**CDA Credential - Infant and Toddler, Part 1** OR **CDA Credential - Preschool, Part 1**) of the 12-part CDA package.
